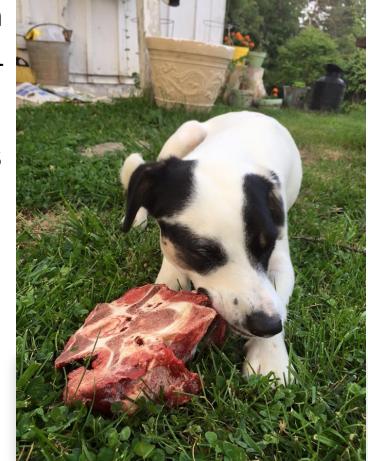

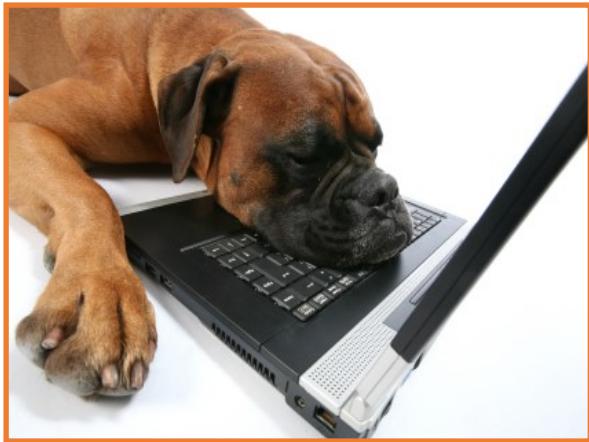

Changes to All Things Pawssible's Liability Waiver

We have changed the following statement in our Liability Waiver from "I also agree to provide proof of immunizations of this dog stating that it has been immunized against distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, canine parvovirus, and rabies." to "All Things Pawssible does not require yearly vaccinations and we will accept naturally reared puppies. We do not require the Bordatella vaccine and ask should you choose to give this vaccine that you keep your dog out of our facility for two weeks to avoid shedding the virus on/near other dogs. We do ask that you agree to provide proof of immunizations or exemption/titer of this dog stating that he/she has been immunized against rabies."
